
A modestly sized lawn provides plenty of space for children or pets to play, and raised garden beds are ready for growing fresh vegetables.

Welcome to Chemainus


Chemainus, a picturesque community on the east coast of southern Vancouver Island, British Columbia, boasts a rich history and vibrant cultural scene. Established as a logging town in 1858, its name originates from the native shaman and prophet "Tsa-meeun-is," meaning "broken chest," who, according to legend, survived a severe chest wound to become a powerful chief.

The town's economy flourished with the arrival of the railway in the 1880s, and by the early 1920s, the population had grown to 600. As of 2021, Chemainus is home to approximately 4,033 residents.

Chemainus is renowned for its 53 outdoor murals, transforming the town into a vast outdoor art gallery and attracting tourists worldwide. This initiative revitalized the community after the closure of its large sawmill in the early 1980s.

The town hosts several popular local events, including the Chemainus Bluegrass Festival and the Chemainus Theatre Festival, celebrating its rich musical and theatrical heritage. Visitors can also explore the Chemainus Valley Museum to delve deeper into the area's history.

Today, Chemainus stands as a testament to community resilience and creativity, seamlessly blending its historical roots with a thriving arts and culture scene.
